BOOKING INFORMATION

The following information is intended to make you aware of what is involved in your booking and of any pitfalls that may detract from the enjoyment of your trip. Please read it carefully and contact us should you have any questions.

Booking forms:

It is essential that you complete and submit the online booking form included with your booking confirmation email. Submitting this form, and/or making your deposit payment, constitutes an agreement between you and Roxton Fishing Ltd. The booking form also provides us with the necessary information to arrange your trip. Please note that if the form is incomplete, certain services may not be secured, which could affect your overall enjoyment of the experience.

Paying for your trip:

Payment for your trip must be made in the currency stated on your invoice, using the bank transfer details provided at the bottom of the invoice. All bank charges are the responsibility of the sender, and when arranging a telegraphic transfer, you should ensure the option to accept all charges is selected. To ensure your account is credited promptly, please reference all payments, whether by bank transfer or cheque, with your name and booking number. Cheques should be made payable to **Roxtons Fishing Ltd.**

Financial Protection:

Roxtons Fishing is licensed by both the Civil Aviation Authority, ATOL number 12766 and the Association of Bonded Travel Organisers Trust (ABTOT), member number 5658. This means that when you buy a holiday you are protected. ATOL covers flight inclusive packages and ABTOT covers non-flight packages. For more information, please see our terms and conditions.



YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

Please note that passport, visa, and health requirements are subject to change at any time. It is your responsibility to ensure you comply with the current regulations, and Roxtons Fishing cannot accept any liability for failure to do so. You must also ensure that you travel with all relevant and valid documentation.

Passports and Visas:

A full, valid passport is required for all travel outside the UK. Many countries require that your passport be valid for at least six months beyond the date you leave that country, so please check requirements carefully. If you need to renew your passport, allow sufficient time as the application process can take longer than expected. While we are able to assist British passport holders with most visa applications, Roxtons Fishing cannot be held responsible should any country refuse a visa application.

Flights and Seating:

We will advise you on suitable flight options and provide an itinerary for your holiday. Please note that in some destinations, travel schedules may change due to delays, cancellations, adverse weather, or other factors beyond our control. Such changes can result in missed connections and may incur additional costs for accommodation, ticket changes, or rebooking. Roxtons Fishing cannot be held liable for any such delays, schedule changes, or resulting expenses. Airlines also reserve the right to amend flight schedules without prior notice.

Unless otherwise stated, flight prices quoted by Roxtons Fishing are based on restricted special fares or tickets. Once confirmed, these tickets typically do not permit changes or refunds. A copy of the airline's full terms and conditions for your ticket type and class is available on request.

We strongly recommend allowing more than the minimum time required for check-in and airport formalities. Should you miss your flight, airlines may require the purchase of a new ticket, and accommodation providers are unlikely to refund any missed nights. Roxtons Fishing cannot accept responsibility for additional costs incurred in these circumstances.

Some airlines allow requests for specific seats across all classes of travel. This remains subject to the airline's policy, and in some cases, advance payment may be required. Please note that seat allocation is controlled entirely by the airlines, not by Roxtons Fishing.



Health and Special Diets:

If you have any special dietary requirements, please indicate these on your booking form. Please note that, due to the remoteness of some of our destinations, it may not always be possible to always accommodate specific dietary needs.

Travel Insurance:
